Post Entry Fee: \$100 after closing date of March 10, 2024.

Entry Fee Refund Policy: Entries will be refunded in full before closing, provided that the entry can be filled from the waitlist. After Closing Date, no refunds will be provided.

Stall Fee: \$300

MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at Modified Level or above, and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competition and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass Fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) Leadline; 2) Exhibitions; 3) Games and races; 4) classes for 4H members; 5) Walk Trot and Academy Classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF Introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

The time in the cool down will be 10 - 15 minutes.

Restrictions, if any, to multiple times on course: Drivers and/or navigators may go round the marathon course a maximum of 2 times, if schedule allows. This also applies to sharing of carriage or harness. Competitors wishing to share navigators, drivers acting as navigators, carriages or harness must complete the Special Request for Sharing Form. Failure to complete the form will result in the request not being honored. This form must be turned in to the Scorer when competitor numbers are picked up at the show office.

MOTOR VEHICLE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management at their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed unsafe use if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Additional Information

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the US Center for Safe Sport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

Veterinary and Health Requirements: Flu and Rhino within 6 months of show date and Coggins within 1 year of show date.

Awards, Championships and Prize Money (if applicable): 6 ribbons awarded per class, Special Awards. Awards will be presented at the end of the Cones Classes. Prize giving will be done on the carriage.

Food available on grounds: Yes, during competition hours

Dog Policy: All dogs must be on a leash and under control at all times. Please do not take your dogs to the dressage ring or the cones ring during competition, or take your dog into the obstacles . Loose dogs, or dogs dragging a leash, will incur a fine of \$25 for the first offense, \$50 for the second, and so on and will increase by \$25 each time. You will need to come to the show office to pay and to collect your dog.
